Subject Grade Boosters

Grade Booster Workshops aim to help students strengthen and consolidate concepts learnt thus far and also to work ahead on some of the upcoming topics in the syllabus. The complete course runs for 2 sessions and are divided into a number of segments. Each segment targets a specific topic area and would normally include:

- Review and Elaboration of Core Topics
- Identification, and Fine-tuning in the Understanding of Key Concepts
- Learning to Interpret Exam Questions
- Presentation of Concepts Required for Good Answers
- Questions and Discussion

University Application Workshops

IELTS PREP

The workshop is designed for students who are taking the IELTS test in 2018. Over the course of the six hour workshop, students will be introduced to the IELTS test format and its four components: listening, reading, writing and speaking. The aim of this workshop is to provide students with a broad overview, a “snapshot,” of the world’s most popular English test, as well as offering some tips and strategies for tackling each component of the test. In addition, students will have a chance to do practice exercises in class and receive feedback from the teacher.

PERSONAL STATEMENT PREP

The personal statement must leave the admissions tutors with a very strong impression of who YOU are, what YOU are like personally and socially and, critically, why YOU want to study the course you have chosen, at THEIR university. After the workshop, students will have identified the key points in producing an effective and successful personal statement. In addition, students will have a better idea to engage in activities that will give them an advantage in their university application.

All workshops are conducted in small groups of only **3-6 persons** to ensure a high level of interaction between teacher and students. The low student-to-teacher ratio allows a higher degree of customization for the needs of the individual students.
