

## **Summer Workshop Schedule 2017**

### **Key Stage 3 (Year 7 – 9 students)**

We are happy to announce our 2017 summer workshops for Year 7 – 9 students! These workshops are designed to review the fundamentals as well as to introduce them to new and challenging topics that they will encounter in the new school year.

#### **Pre-Keystage 3 MATHS Summer Workshop (For New Year-7 Students)**

This Math workshop is designed to provide new secondary students a smooth transition from primary school. Our tutor will begin with a revision of the fundamentals. Along with the review, explanations to the logic behind each topic will be provided. This way, students can visualize a clearer step-by-step approach to each Maths topic. This is a great tool for interpreting new concepts they will encounter in the new school year.

In order to build a better foundation to succeed in middle school, practices on different algebraic equations will be given. By the end of this workshop, Students will get a clear sense of what to expect.

#### **Pre-IGCSE MATHS Summer Workshop (For New Year-8 & 9 Students)**

This Maths workshop targets new Year 8 and 9 students as an early preparation course to the IGCSE syllabus. Our goal is to ensure students make the connections from the fundamentals learned in the lower secondary (Key-Stage 3) to new concepts in IGCSE, increasing their confidence when dealing with more challenging concepts.

One common issue for many new IGCSE students is that they struggle with providing clear explanations and their logic behind their solutions. Therefore this workshop will focus on teaching students how to apply basic concepts into their answering skills on questions that requires more abstract thinking. It's a great way to get a head start to the new IGCSE level.

#### **Pre-IGCSE ENGLISH Summer Workshop (For New Year 7 to Year 9 Students)**

Are you looking to enhance your child's English reading and writing skills?

The pre-IGCSE English Summer Workshop focuses on preparing Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9) students for transitioning to the IGCSE curriculum.

IGCSE English Language and English Literature courses can be challenging. The summer break is the best time to introduce students to these courses and give them a head-start. Students will learn in an interactive way where they get to collaborate with their peers in a small group setting.

On the language side of things, the workshop will focus on developing students' understanding of the spoken word, their ability to convey meaning through written language, and their skills in reading, interpreting and responding to material from a variety of sources including journalistic texts (news reports, commentary) and promotional and persuasive texts (advertising leaflets, speeches).

As for literature, we will study a range of literary texts, including both prose and poetry. We will analyze the techniques that authors employ whilst exploring the many facets of life through literature. Students will learn to critically read, interpret and evaluate literary texts.
