



## **HKETS Summer Workshop for University Application 2017** for IB and A level students

This summer, in addition to public exam workshops and UK key stage 3 workshops, HKETS will be running 2 workshops for dedicated students who want to make effective use of their term-break to prepare for their university application. Our University Application Workshops are for those applying to UK and HK Universities.

### **IELTS Workshop**

This is for students taking the IELTS in 2017/18. Those sitting the exam for the first time will benefit from a greater understanding of the exam's format and practice in all four areas of Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking. Many students in Hong Kong take the IELTS to supplement the language requirements for universities. Throughout the course, students will be able to practice IELTS questions and get feedback from the teacher directly. Exam techniques or strategies will also be taught alongside each of the different components so that students are prepared for all question types and patterns.

### **Personal Statement Workshop**

A Personal Statement is what differentiates university applicants from one another. An excellent personal statement is reflective of a student's ambitions, achievements and experiences. In order to stand out from the crowd, a personal statement should show a student's transferable skills - do they know their subject matter? And have they been active in seeking out opportunities for further learning both inside and outside of school? The aim of this workshop is to teach students the skeleton of an effective personal statement followed by practice in evaluating sample personal statements and finally, the opportunity to plan and write their own statements. This workshop will cover the differing styles of writing personal statements and guide on having the right format. Students looking to submit university applications in 2017/18 are invited to join this workshop and stay a step ahead!
