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Key Stage 2 & 3

This year, we are proud to introduce a new set of courses for our younger students in Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3. Many of them were affected by the distance learning as well as the lack of continuity of face-to-face class time at school. Our courses aim to help fill in the gaps of their learning and boost their confidence heading into the new academic year.



ENGLISH

Guided Reading (Tuesdays at 10 AM - 12 NOON)

This course is designed for students who could use guidance when reading, both in a group setting, and on their own. They will gain practice in public speaking to boost their overall confidence level. The students will experience a range of literature, from creative to scientific and together they will explore the themes and technicalities of each writing style. The students will also learn independent research methods to help with their future reading skills.

Grammar Lab (Wednesdays 10 AM - 12 NOON)

This course is designed for students who either struggle with grammar or are looking to excel their written and spoken language skills. The students will develop a strong understanding of grammatical rules and learn to identify these in any given text. The aim of the course is to improve the daily use of language to help the students find ways to express themselves more accurately and with greater eloquence.



MATHEMATICS

This course is designed for students who need further practice on skills they have been learning over the previous years. Due to the remote learning, many students have struggled to develop a tangible understanding of mathematical skills. This course aims to realign the students so that they are well prepared for the upcoming academic year. The students will revisit topics introduced to them through different engagement styles; tactile learning, sensory processing and cognitive reasoning, in order to cement their skills.
